## Receive **SUPPORT**

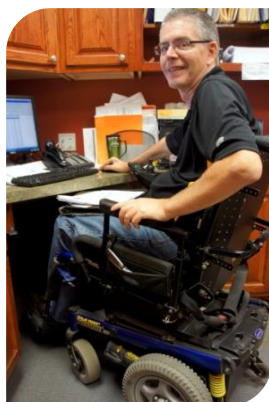
Offering information and assistance as you care for a family member, loved one, or neighbor.
